Arizona is such a large state that many classes cannot travel the miles to visit our museum in Phoenix to take advantage of our exhibits and the educational presentations which are based on the AZ Science Standards and AZ Core Curriculum. Therefore, the Arizona Mining and Mineral Museum would like to bring its grade-appropriate statewide Outreach Classroom Series to your classroom if your school is located in a school district outside of Maricopa County.

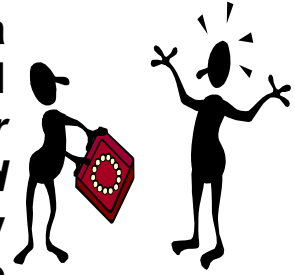

These thoroughly enjoyable and fast-paced classroom programs are presented to students studying our state's geology, mining, and mineral resources as mandated by the Arizona Department of Education's Core Curriculum and State Science Standards. The students discover some surprising practical uses of rocks and minerals, do some hands-on activities, and watch a short video. Presentations are made to no more than two classes at a time. Only three hour-long presentations per school visit can be scheduled. Each presentation includes the really fantastic Black Light Exhibit and the opportunity for the students to take a good look at our traveling mini-museum.



Each classroom teacher will receive a packet of information sheets. Each teacher will receive one of our justly acclaimed *Teacher Identification Kit of Arizona Rocks and Minerals*, which has been assembled by volunteers at the Museum, and is therefore available without charge. This box is full of valuable printed information, a detailed identification guide, information, and 46-48 samples of Arizona rocks and minerals.



Costs for presentations are as follows: \$50.00 per class plus a mileage fee. For 2008-2010 there

*is funding available, thanks to the generosity of The Freeport-McMoran Copper & Gold Foundation.*

Since 2005, the *Friends of the Arizona Mining and Mineral Museum* has been applying for program funding. For 2008-2010 a generous grant from the Freeport-McMoran Copper and Gold Foundation was received. This enables classrooms located outside Central Maricopa County to waive the costs of the *Have Rocks - Will Travel* presentations. Once funds are depleted, the cost will revert to the \$50.00 + mileage. Remember: no school is too small or too distant.

*Books and Kits from our Bibliography can be ordered for delivery on presentation day. Treasure Bags can be ordered in advance for each student (only \$2<sup>00</sup> ea) and will be delivered on the day of the presentation. The bags can be purchased by the student, the PTO or equivalent, or the school/district. Each drawstring Treasure Bag contains three rock and/or mineral specimens, a polished mystery stone, a post card of the museum, and a printed bookmark.*
